He has worked as an attorney for Bonner County, the Ada County Prosecutor's Office, and in private practice.

He was chosen to assume his father's seat in the Idaho House of Representatives following Pat Bieter's untimely death in 1999, and went on to serve through five sessions of the Legislature.

In addition to serving on the Board of Directors of the Boise Metro Chamber of Commerce, Mayor Bieter has served as an ex officio member of the Downtown Business Association and a member of the Catholic Charities of Idaho social action committee. He also has extensive ties to the city's Basque community, having founded the Boise Basque Choir, performed with the Basque dance troupe, and served as a board member of the Basque Center and Basque Charities. He has been married to his wife, Julia, since 1998.
